#### **CityNet- Kuala Lumpur Regional Training Centre 35<sup>th</sup> Session: “Reshaping the Urban Landscape: Advancing Green Solutions in the Disrupted World”**

#### **Rationale:**

CityNet and the Kuala Lumpur Regional Training Center are organizing its 37<sup>th</sup> CityNet-KLRTC Session online on July 26-27, 2021. The session will gather international city participants and urban multi stakeholders from the Asia Pacific region to reflect on the sustainability trends, exchange best practices, and generate insights on the reshaping of urban landscape in the post-pandemic recovery regime.

The European Union, the United States, South Korea, and other developed economies have embarked on a green and digital revolution as their long-term blueprint on their road to recovery from impact of COVID-19.

However, for most of Asia and its developing economies, embarking on a green and digital roadmap present deep challenges as they have yet to have a fully developed infrastructure and technical capacity to support their leapfrogging of their green and digital agenda. Benchmarking from best practices within the context of green and digital revolution can help fill these gaps and accelerate the process.

#### **Objectives:**

The two day session will feature conversations and learning opportunities on the many ways to raise the prospect of adopting green and digital solutions as key sustainable strategies for the post-COVID-19 urban recovery. The following objectives are as follows:

1. To promote the general understanding on the green and digital strategies as tools to accelerate urban recovery in the post-COVID-19 era;
2. To learn on the different green and digital urban solutions with the prospect to localize the identified solutions and identify their different replicability factors;
3. To learn on the different tools that support the prospect on the replication and development of green and digital solutions.

### **Target Participants:**

A total of 15-20 international participants will be invited in this exclusive two day workshop. A Certificate of Completion will also be awarded upon completion of the program.
