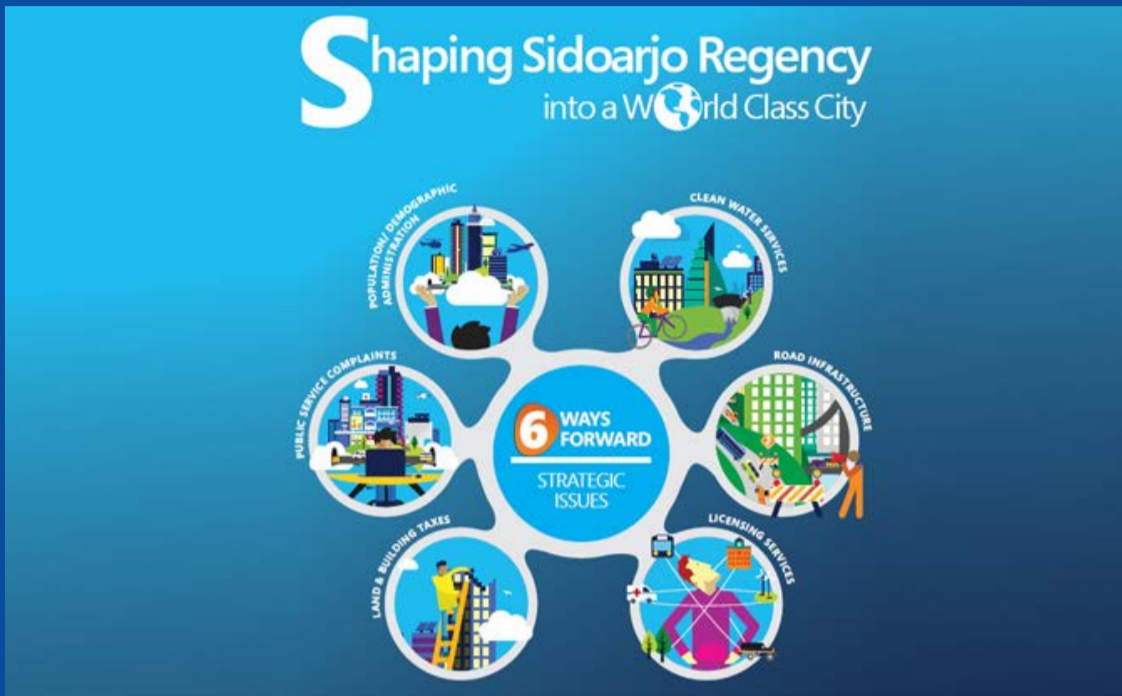

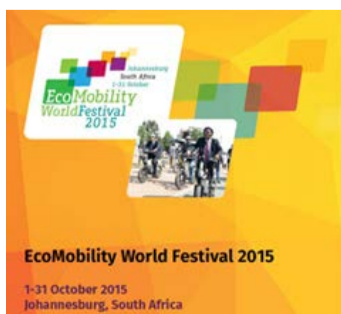
Safer Cities: Interview with Dr. Alioune Badiane
