What are the roles of urban lighting in a city?

Light not only presents a unique opportunity to fundamentally improve the safety of a city, it can also turn a city into a more attractive and vibrant place to be. Moreover, in the near future, lighting will present more opportunities to connect with people through a variety of technologies.

Last year, the ‘2017 Asian Urban Lighting Workshop’ concluded successfully with the active participation of 16 city representatives from 8 countries in Asia. It gave a strong sense of the varied range of issues in which Asian cities need to engage in order to carry out strategic urban lighting. It was a valuable opportunity for Asian cities to break down interurban boundaries and research together.

Under the theme of ‘The Role of Urban Lighting for Sustainable Development in Asian cities’, this workshop is classified into 6 subtopics, such as “People”, “Safety”, “Culture”, “Economy”, “Environment”, and “Future”. You will be welcomed with excellent speeches on urban lighting from the different city representatives. We will also provide time for discussion and inter-city exchanges to help your city as it moves forward with its lighting projects.
