CityNet Climate Leadership Program 3 November 18-20, 2019, Denpasar, Bali, Indonesia

CityNet with Jakarta Capital City Government and Denpasar City as the host city are organizing its third international series of Climate Leadership Program on November 18-20, 2019 in Denpasar, Indonesia.

The Program aims to add value to the leadership capacities of climate change practitioners in the Asia Pacific with the end view of helping them transform their communities while addressing impacts of climate change.

This activity also presents an opportunity for peer-based exchange of best practices of both innovative national and local climate actions. This activity will further accelerate the knowledge exchanges of practical tools and tried and tested processes for the development of sustainable urban solutions to mitigate impacts of climate change.

The general objectives of this Program:

1. To learn and familiarize basic leadership and problem solving approaches using U theory and systems design thinking and practical ways on how they can apply in the analytical process on climate-related challenges;
2. To exchange information and insights on emerging global trends, regional situationers on climate change, local innovations and sustainable urban solutions relative to climate action;
3. To learn on different prototypes on climate change solutions and build further conversations as to how they can scale up and raise the prospect of replications to other countries;
4. To develop action plans and further prospects on sustainable city to city cooperation through different CityNet programs.
